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REMINDER TO STUDENTS

EARLIER DEADLINE TO SIGN UP WITH METAIRIE BANK

We have learned that the sign-up deadline for the 10-month tuition loan is next Wednesday, May 28th. Parents who currently have a tuition loan have been sent the forms to sign and return to Metairie Bank. If you are interested in the 9-month loan, the deadline date is June 20th. We would appreciate it if you would send your school application and fee to the office before you apply to Metairie Bank so that we will have an accurate count of students for next year. Remember, **May 28th is the deadline to apply for the 10-month loan.**
