## **HURRICANE EVACUATION INFORMATION**

In order to keep in contact with our school families if an evacuation order is given or you choose to leave the city for a hurricane, we are giving you this information to be placed in your evacuation kit.

When you arrive at your safe destination, please call Ms. Loughmiller (281) 799-9883 or Martin Insurance (888) 415-2006 and leave your name and a phone number where you can be reached. It is very important that we hear from each family.
